RESOLUTION NO. 365

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8,
WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REQUIRING
AN APPLICATION FOR PERMIT AND PERMIT AND
INSPECTION FEE FOR PRIVATELY INSTALLED
METERS ON THE WATER DISTRICT'S
SYSTEM AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 240

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Whatcom
County Water District No. 8, Whatcom County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Application required. Prior to the installation
of any private water meter on the water system operated by Whatcom
County Water District No. 8, an application therefore shall on an
appropriate form provided by the District shall be filed by special
interest group, owner or agent of the owner requesting said meter
at the District Office. A permit application shall be supplemented
by any plans, specifications or other information considered pertinent
in the judgment of the District. The location of the meter will be
determined by the Water District through consultation with the
owner of the property with the final decision resting with the Water
District. Upon approval of the application and upon the payment of
a fee of \$25.00 the District shall issue a permit to the applicant.
Said permit shall be authorization to the applicant to proceed with
installation of the meter in accordance with the permit.

Section 2. Work to be done according to permit. If the
applicant proceeds with installation in any manner other than as
authorized by the permit, the District may require the applicant to
redue any work that is not done in accordance with the permit.

Section 3. Time limit on permit. Any permit authorized
hereunder shall be valid for a period of Ninety (90) days unless
extented or renewed by the District when good cause is shown upon
application therefore, prior to the orginal expiration date. A
renewed permit shall be valid for not more than Thirty (30) days.
There shall be no charge for renewals.

Section 4. Inspection. All meters installation shall be inspected by the District. No persons shall cover or backfill any meter installation without having approval from the District to do so. The District shall be given a request for inspection at least twenty four (24) hours prior to the completion of the installation. If any person covers or backfills any meter installation without having obtained District approval, the District shall require the installation be uncovered so that proper inspection can be made. Following inspection and acceptance the completed meter becomes the property of Water District, provided the meter is located in the public right-of-way or on an easement granted to the District.
