RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, RAISING THE CHARGES FOR USE OF ITS SEWER SYSTEM, FIXING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SERVICE AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NOS. 139 and 301.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Whatcom County Water District No. 8, Whatcom County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Resolution No. 130 and Section 1 of Resolution No. 301 shall be amended to reas as follows:

- The following rates and charges for furnished sewage disposal services to property within the District, where available, whether or not a connection to the sewage system of the District has been made, within the following classifications of users, are hereby fixed and shall be paid therefore, to-wit:
 - a. Residential within the District: \$7.50 per living unit per month;
 - b. Residential outside the District: \$11.25 per living unit per month;
 - c. Commercial (Public Retail, Non-Residential): \$7.50 per month minimum charge for the first 1,000 cubic feet per month of water usage, plus \$0.65 per month per cubic feet or part thereof in excess of 1,000 cubic feet;
 - d. Industrial (any non-governmental user of publicly owned treatment works identified in the Standard Industrial Classification Manual 1972, Office Management and Budget, as amended and supplemented under the following divisions; Division A: Argiculture, Forestry and Fishing; Division B: Mining; Division D: Manufacturing; Division E: Transportation, communication, electric, gas and sanitary services; Division I: Services; A user in the Divisions listed may be excluded if it is determined that it will introduce primarily segregated domestic wastes or wastes from sanitary conveniences): Rates to be established individually by contract to be commensurate with other charges in the District, however, rates will comply with the Federal Guidelines and/or regulations pursuant to the Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972.
 - e. Extended Service: \$2.00 per unit per month; extended service rates apply to washrooms, laundry rooms, bath houses and all other similar installations.

Section 2: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the sewer service charges herein adopted.

Section 3: The effective date of this ordinance shall be March 17 , 1981.
