

RESOLUTION NO. 412

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS OF BIRCH BAY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 75, 222, 320, 382, and 389, ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING FOR WATER SERVICE AND GENERAL FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Water Commissioners of Birch Bay Water District No. 8 are required to establish water changes within the District to provide for the provision of water services within said District; and

WHEREAS, Birch Bay Water District No. 8 has determined that the current water rates are insufficient to operate the water utility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Water Commissioners of Birch Bay Water District No. 8 of Whatcom County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: Section IV, subsection A of Resolution No. 75 and Section 2 of Resolution No. 222 and Section 1 of Resolutions No. 320, 382 and 389 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Monthly Water Rates:

Class 1 - Residential Inside District	\$5.00
Class 2 - Residential Outside District	\$7.50
Class 3 - Commercial	\$5.00
Class 4 - Commercial Outside District	\$7.50
Class 5 - Industrial	(not yet set)
Class 6 - Extended Service	\$1.00

In addition to the above monthly charges, customers shall be charged eighty cents (\$.80) for each 100 cubic feet of water used by them.

Section 2: The remainder of Resolutions No. 75 and 222, 320, 382 and 389, with the exception of those sections amended by other resolutions, shall remain unchanged.

Section 3: This resolution shall be effective January 1, 1985.
