

RESOLUTION NO. 415

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS OF  
BIRCH BAY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON,  
ESTABLISHING A POLICY OF ACCELERATION  
OF ULID ASSESSMENTS DUE IN THE  
FUTURE ON ACCOUNTS DELINQUENT MORE THAN  
TWO YEARS.

WHEREAS, Birch Bay Water District No. 8 has several outstanding  
U.L.I.D.'s on which some assessments have become delinquent; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.50.040 allows the District to provide that the  
entire balance of both principal and interest shall be due when  
the assessments become delinquent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Water Commissioners  
of Birch Bay Water District No. 8 of Whatcom County, Washington,  
as follows;

Section 1: Whenever the annual payments on any U.L.I.D. created  
by Birch Bay Water District No. 8 are two years delinquent, and  
foreclosure action is to be begun, the commissioners may, without  
notice to the property owner, declare the entire balance of all  
future principal, and all interest and penalties then due, shall  
be and are immediately due and payable in full.

Section 2: All other resolutions or parts thereof in conflict  
herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This resolution shall be effective immediately.
