RESOLUTION NO. 439

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS OF BIRCH BAY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 75, 222, 320, 382, 389, 412 AND 433, ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATION AND PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING FOR WATER SERVICE AND GENERAL FACILITIES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Water Commissioners of Birch Bay Water District No. 8 of Whatcom County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: Section IV, Subsection A of Resolution No. 75 and Section 2 of Resolution No. 222 and Section 1 of Resolutions No. 320, 382, 389, 412, and 433 are hereby amended to read as follows:

In addition to the above monthly charges, customers shall be charged eighty cents (\$.80) for each 100 cubic feet of water used by them. Provided, however, that where a meter larger than 3/4 inch is installed for fire protection purposes, and the actual usage of water through that meter is less than one-half of the average usage for a residential unit in any twelve (12) month period, the charge shall be for two (2) equivalent living units, plus water usage charges.

Section 2: The remainder of Resolutions No. 75, 222, 320, 382, 389, 412 and 433 with the exception of those sections amended by other resolutions, shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective January 1, 1987.
