

RESOLUTION NO. 499

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REVISING SECTION 7.04.070 AND
7.04.090 OF THE BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT CODE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

Section 1: Section 7.04.070 of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code is revised to read as follows:

7.04.070 Service Connection Charge--Meter-only Charge.

A. A service connection charge or meter-only charge must be paid to the district before water service will be made available to the premises. A service connection charge shall be the total cost for installing a service connection to the property line, including meter and all necessary fittings. The meter-only charge shall be the total cost for installing a meter only on an existing service line. Such charges for a primary service connection shall be:

	Service Connection	Meter Only Charge
3/4"	\$475.00	\$325.00
1"	\$690.00	
Over 1"	Time and materials plus 15% overhead but in no case less than \$1,490.00.	

B. A charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per meter shall be made when there is a change of ownership after the initial application for service, if, but only if, a separate meter reading and a final billing are requested or necessary. This amount is to be paid at the time of notification of ownership change or with the first billing for service.

Section 2: Section 7.04.090 of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code is revised to read as follows:

7.04.090 Charge in Lieu of Assessment for Local Facilities. In any application for service for premises, if the owner or former owners have not paid a proportionate share of the construction cost of the main fronting the premises, there will be a charge in lieu of assessment. A charge in lieu of assessment shall be paid in full before water service is supplied to the premises. The charge in lieu of assessment shall be calculated at the rate of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per front foot. In cases of tracts larger than one acre, a lot of one hundred front feet may be segregated for computing the charge in lieu of assessment.

Section 3: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of

the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect on July 11, 1991.
