

RESOLUTION NO. 539

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM  
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING  
RESOLUTION NOS. 496 AND 502 REGARDING  
WATER USE CHARGES AND BILLING

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

Section 1: Section I of Resolution No. 496 and Section 1 of Resolution No. 502 and Section 7.04.120 of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code are amended to read as follows:

A. Minimum Monthly Charge. The minimum monthly water availability charge for each equivalent living unit is as follows:

Monthly Water Rates:

Class 1 - Residential Inside District	\$4.70
per equivalent living unit	
Class 2 - Residential Outside District	\$7.05
per equivalent living unit	
Class 3 - Commercial Inside District	\$4.70
per equivalent living unit	
Class 4 - Commercial Outside District	\$7.05
per equivalent living unit	
Class 5 - Industrial	(not set yet)
Class 6 - Extended Service	\$1.00
(Restrooms and standpipes not part of a residential or commercial building shall be considered Extended Service Units unless they are only for use by paying tenants of a recreational vehicle park)	

B. Water Use Charge.

1. Water Use Within the District: In addition to the above monthly charges, customers shall be charged ONE AND 50/100THS DOLLARS (\$1.50) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them. Provided, however, that customers shall be charged TWO AND 25/100THS DOLLARS (\$2.25) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them in excess of ONE THOUSAND (1000) cubic feet per month. AND provided further that where a meter larger than 3/4 inch is installed for fire protection purposes, and the actual usage of water through that meter is less than one-half of the average usage for a residential unit in any twelve (12) month period, the charge will be for two (2) equivalent living units, plus water usage charges.

2. Water Use Outside the District: In addition to the above monthly charges, customers shall be charged TWO AND 25/100THS DOLLARS (\$2.25) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them. Provided, however, that customers shall be charged THREE AND 35/100THS DOLLARS (\$3.35) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet

of water used by them in excess of ONE THOUSAND (1000) cubic feet per month. AND provided further that where a meter larger than 3/4 inch is installed for fire protection purposes, and the actual usage of water through that meter is less than one-half of the average usage for a residential unit in any twelve (12) month period, the charge will be for two (2) equivalent living units, plus water usage charges.


Section 2: Section 4 of Resolution 433 and Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code Section 7.04.150 are hereby amended to read as follows:

7.04.150 Billing and Handling Charge: In addition to all other charges set forth herein, each billing unit shall be charged a billing and handling charge of ONE AND 50/100THS DOLLARS (\$1.50) per month for services located within the District boundaries and TWO AND 25/100THS DOLLARS (\$2.25) per month for services located outside the District boundaries.

Section 3: The remainder of Resolutions No. 496 and 502, with the exception of those sections amended by other resolutions, shall remain unchanged.

Section 4: This Resolution regarding the shall be in full force and effect on March 1, 1994.
