A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REGARDING BILLING STATEMENT PERIOD,
REPEALING SECTIONS AND ADDING NEW SECTIONS TO THE BIRCH BAY WATER
AND SEWER DISTRICT CODE

BE-IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

Section 1: Sections 7.04.160 and 8.12.050 are hereby repealed.

Section 2: There is added to Chapter 7.04 of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code a new Section as follows:

7.04.170 Billing Period. For the purposes of this Resolution, the terms "per month" and "monthly" shall mean the billing period of the District for each customer if the District bills monthly, or one-half of the billing period if the District bills bi-monthly. If the District billing period is other than monthly or bi-monthly, "per month" or "monthly" shall mean any 30-day period following the last day of the prior billing period and any period of fewer days where the billing period contains more than an even multiple of 30-day periods, provided, however, that the monthly service charge shall be prorated for any portion of a month within any billing period where that portion of a month is less than twenty-four (24) days. Any proration shall be based upon a presumption that every month contains thirty (30) days.

Section 3: There is added to Chapter 8.12 of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code a new Section as follows:

8.12.051 Billing Period. For the purposes of this Resolution, the terms "per month" and "monthly" shall mean the billing period of the District for each customer if the District bills monthly, or one-half of the billing period if the District bills bi-monthly. If the District billing period is other than monthly or bi-monthly, "per month" or "monthly" shall mean any 30-day period following the last day of the prior billing period and any period of fewer days where the billing period contains more than an even multiple of 30-day periods, provided, however, that the monthly service charge shall be prorated for any portion of a month within any billing period where that portion of a month is less than twenty-four (24) days. Any proration shall be based upon a presumption that every month contains thirty (30) days.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect on July 3 /, 1995.
