

RESOLUTION NO. 566

A Resolution of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer district
reducing the final assessment rolls for Utility Local Improvement
Districts No. 15.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 556 the Board levied assessments against properties located in Utility Local Improvement District No. 15 (the "District"), which was created to finance sewer improvements along Holeman Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the improvements have been constructed in the District and the final costs of the improvements were less than the estimate used to determine the assessment rolls for the District;

Now, therefore the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington, hereby resolves as follows:

The assessments in the District shall be reduced as shown on the attachments to this resolution. If a property owner has prepaid their assessment, the Treasurer of the District shall mail a check to such property owner in an amount equal to the difference between their original assessment and their revised assessment. The treasurer shall mail to the remaining property owners a notice indicating their revised assessment amount. Such checks and notices shall be mailed within 30 days. The revised assessment rolls for the Utility Local Improvement District shall be posted on the books of this District.
