WHEREAS, Developer DOUG CONNELLY (hereinafter "Developer"), has completed and the District has received from Developer a Bill of Sale for said water and sewer distribution main extension lines, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer district, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:


Section 1: The District hereby accepts the water and sewer lines and appurtenances transferred to the District by Developer's Bill of Sale, a copy of which is attached hereto as EXHIBIT A.





The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.
