## RESOLUTION NO. 623

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BIRCH BAY WATER & SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION No. 609, REGARDING WATER USE CHARGES

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Resolution No. 609, shall be amended to read as follows:

A. <u>Minimum Monthly Charge</u>. The minimum monthly water availability charge for each equivalent living unit is as follows:

## B. Water Use Charge.

Water Use Within the District: In addition to the above monthly charges, customers shall be charged ONE AND 80/100 DOLLARS (\$1.80) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them; provided, however, that customers shall be charged TWO AND 70/100 DOLLARS (\$2.70) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them in excess of TWO THOUSAND (2,000) cubic feet per two (2) month period; and provided further that where a meter larger than ¾ inch is installed for fire protection purposes, and the actual usage of water through that meter is less than one-half of the average usage for a residential unit in any twelve (12) month period, the charge will be for two (2) equivalent living units, plus water usage charges.

Water Use Outside the District. In addition to the above monthly charges, customers shall be charged TWO AND 70/100 DOLLARS (\$2.70) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them; provided, however, that customers shall be charged FOUR AND 05/100 DOLLARS (\$4.05) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them in excess of TWO THOUSAND (2,000) cubic feet per two (2) month period; and provided further that where a meter larger than ¼ inch is installed for fire protection purposes, and the actual usage of water through that meter is less than one-half of the average usage for a residential unit in any twelve (12) month period, the charge will be for two (2) equivalent living units, plus water usage charges.

Section 2: Section 2 of Resolution No. 609, shall be amended to read as follows:

7.04.150 <u>Billing and Handling Charge</u>: In addition to all other charges set forth herein, each billing unit shall be charged a billing and handling charge of ONE AND 70/100 DOLLARS (\$1.70) per month for services located inside the District boundaries and TWO AND 50/100 DOLLARS (\$2.50) per month for services located outside the District boundaries.

Section 3: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution: The Board hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be effective with billing after April 1, 2003.
