

RESOLUTION NO. 162

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 149.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the commissioners of Whatcom County Water District No. 8, that certain problems are developing with the installation of septic tanks and the granting of septic tanks by the County of Whatcom; and,

WHEREAS, the commissioners desire an orderly development of a policy by which septic tank permits can be obtained prior to the availability of working sewer service, and,

WHEREAS, this power is within the scope of authority granted to this Board of Water commissioners it is therefore resolved by the Board of Water Commissioners, Whatcom County Water District No. 8 that there shall be a new section added to Resolution No. 149 which shall be known as 2.07 and shall read as follows:

2.07 All persons desiring to construct or place any building, mobile home or other structure to be used for human occupancy within the boundaries of Whatcom County Water District No. 8 shall be hereby required to obtain from this District a letter of "sewer availability" or "sewer non-availability" PRIOR to applying to the Whatcom County Health Department for a septic tank permit and/or the Whatcom County Building Department for a building permit. Septic tank permits and/or building permits may be issued ONLY AFTER presentation of said letter.
