## RESOLUTION NO. 166

A RESOLUTION OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8 AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1 ENTITLED "A RESOLUTION FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8", AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 65, AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 115.

this resolution to the Whatcom County Treasurer and Whatcom
County Auditor.

Section 3: That said Resolutions Nos. 1, 65, and 115 of said Water District No. 8 are hereby amended as above set forth and that in all other respects the said Resolutions Nos. 1, 65, and 115 be and are in effect as amended herein.
