WHEREAS, Whatcom County Water District No. 8, Whatcom County, Washington, (hereinafter called "the District"), has authorized planning, research and acquisition of property necessary for the construction, installation and maintenance of additions to the water distribution system, including pipeline and water storage tank; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and in the best interest of the District that said project proceed as rapidly as possible to conclusion, it appearing that securing complete, voluntary cooperation from the property owners would be extremely time-consuming and would delay the construction of said project unduly,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Whatcom County Water District No. 8, Whatcom County, Washington, as follows:

That LeCocq, Simonarson, Visser and Johnson are authorized to institute condemnation proceedings against the property described on the attached Exhibit "A" incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

Said counsel shall have the authority to conduct all procedures required by law for completion of the condemnation action.
