

RESOLUTION NO. 23

A RESOLUTION transferring the sum of \$10,850.00 from the construction fund of Water District No. 8 of Whatcom County, Washington, to the bond redemption fund of Water District No. 8 in order to provide sufficient funds to meet the bond interest coming due February 1, 1971 on the bonds issued by the purchase of the water system of Whatcom County Water District No. 8.

County Water

WHEREAS, Whatcom/District No. 8 must meet interest payments on their revenue bond issue for the purchase of the water system of Water District No. 8 on February 1, 1971 in the sum of \$10,850.00, and

WHEREAS there are insufficient funds in the bond redemption fund to meet said obligation, and

WHEREAS there are sufficient funds now on hand in the construction fund of said Water District No. 8 and that it is necessary and proper that sufficient funds, to-wit: The sum of \$10,850.00 be transferred from the construction fund to the bond redemption fund to meet said obligation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Treasurer of Whatcom County, Washington, be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$10,850.00 from the construction fund of Water District No. 8 of Whatcom County, Washington, to the bond redemption fund of Whatcom County Water District No. 8 for the purpose of meeting the bond interest due and payable February 1, 1971, in the sum of \$10,850.00.
