RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, RAISING THE CHARGES FOR USE OF ITS SEWER SYSTEM, FIXING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SERVICE AND AMENDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 139, 301, AND 383.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Whatcom County Water District No. 8, Whatcom County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Resolution No. 139 and Section 1 of Resolution Nos. 301 and 383 shall be amended to read as follows:

- The following rates and charges for furnishing sewage disposal services to property within the district, where available, whether or not a connection to the sewage system of the District has been made, within the following classifications of users, are hereby fixed and shall be paid therefore, to-wit:
  - Residential within the district: \$8.50 per living unit per month; plus twenty cents (\$.20) per one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used at said residence up to a maximum of six hundred (600) cubic feet per month.
  - b. Residential outside the district: \$12.75 per living unit per month; plus thirty cents (\$.30) per one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used at said residence up to a maximum of six hundred (600) cubic feet.
  - Commercial (Public Retail, Non-Residential): \$8.50 per month minimum charge per business plus twenty cents (\$.20) per 100 cubic feet of water used.
  - Industrial (any non-governmental user of publicly owned treatment works indentified in the Standard Industrial Classification Manual 1972, Office Management and Budget, as amended and supplemented under the following divisions; Division A: Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing; Division B: Mining; Division D: Manufacturing; Division F: Transportation communications Division E: Transportation, communications, electric, gas and sanitary services; Division I: Services; A user in the Divisions listed
    may be excluded if it is determined that it
    will introduce primarily segregated domestic
    wastes from sanitary conveniences)
    Rates to be established individually by contract to be commensurate with other charges in the District, however, rates will comply with the Federal Guidelines and/or regulations pursuant to the Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972.

Section 2: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolution or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the sewer service charges herein adopted.

Section 3: 1, 1983. The effective date of this resolution shall be July
