A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NAME OF WHATCOM
COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8 TO BIRCH BAY
WATER DISTRICT NO. 8

WHEREAS, Whatcom County Water District No. 8 serves the Birch Bay area; and

WHEREAS, there has in the past been a great deal of confusion over what the name of the water district is which serves the Birch Bay area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WHATCOM COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 8, as follows:

Section 1: The Board of Commissioners of Whatcom County Water District No. 8 hereby declare their intention, subject to the approval of the Whatcom County Council and Executive, to change the name of the district to Birch Bay Water District No. 8 for the reason that the name Birch Bay Water District No. 8 will more closely reflect the service offered by the district and the service area of the district.

Section 2: This resolution shall be effective upon its approval by the Whatcom County Council and Executive.
