RESOLUTION NO. 487

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, CONCERNING WATER GENERAL FACILITIES CHARGES

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Resolutions 414, 479 and any other resolution which sets general facilities charges for water service are hereby amended to read as follows:

Any application for water service shall be subject to a general facilities charge of THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100THS DOLLARS (\$300.00) per equivalent living unit to be connected to the District's water system in addition to any connection, permit or inspection fees otherwise applicable.

<u>Section 2</u>: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4</u>: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately.
