A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 75, 222,
320, 382, 389, 412, 433, AND 439 ESTABLISHING RULES,
REGULATION AND PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING FOR WATER SERVICE
AND GENERAL FACILITIES

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Section IV, Subsection A of Resolution No. 75 and Section 2 of Resolution No. 222 and Section 1 of Resolutions No. 320, 382, 389, 412, 433, 439 and Section 7.04.120 of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

A. <u>Minimum Monthly Charge</u>. The minimum monthly water availability charge for each equivalent living unit is as follows:

Monthly Water Rates:

Class 1 - Residential Inside District \$4.50 per equivalent living unit

Class 2 - Residential Outside District \$6.75 per equivalent living unit

Class 3 - Commercial Inside District \$4.50 per equivalent living unit

Class 4 - Commercial Outside District \$6.75 per equivalent living unit

Class 5 - Industrial (not set yet)
Class 6 - Extended Service \$1.00

(Restrooms and standpipes not part of a residential or commercial building shall be considered Extended Service Units unless they are only for use by paying tenants of a recreational vehicle park)

B. Water Use Charge. In addition to the above monthly charges, customers shall be charged ONE AND NO/100THS DOLLAR (\$1.00) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them. Provided, however, that customers shall be charged ONE AND 50/100THS DOLLARS (\$1.50) for each one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used by them in excess of one thousand (1000) cubic feet per month. AND provided further that where a meter larger than 3/4 inch is installed for fire protection purposes, and the actual usage of water through that meter is less than one-half of the average usage for a residential unit in any twelve (12) month period, the charge shall be for two (2) equivalent living units, plus water usage charges.

<u>Section 2</u>: The remainder of Resolutions No. 75, 22, 320, 382, 389, 412, 433, and 439, with the exception of those sections amended by other resolutions, shall remain unchanged.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect on May 1, 1991.
