Every other Thursday, commencing as of December 5, 1991, at 4:30 p.m., at the premises known as the office of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom county, Washington, located at the base of the Grange Hall at 4895 Birch Bay Lynden road, Blaine, washington, are fixed as the time, date and place for regular meetings of the board of commissioners; and such meetings shall be so held until further act of the board of commissioners.

<u>Section 2</u>: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4</u>: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect on November <u>>5</u>, 1991.
