AMENDED RESOLUTION NO. 522

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

<u>Section A</u>: There is added to Chapter 7.04 of the Birch Bay Water and Sewer District Code a new section as follows:

7.04.081 General Facilities Charge. Any application for water service shall be subject to a general facilities charge of ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETEEN AND NO/100THS DOLLARS (\$1,119.00) per equivalent living unit to be connected to the District's water system in addition to any connection, permit or inspection fees otherwise applicable.

Section B:

7.04.083 Credit. Any property, which has previously paid for water service, and has continually received water service through a private water system, but has not paid a general facilities charge, shall receive a credit of \$412.00 against the charge levied in paragraph A hereof. Any property which has previously paid a general facilities charge, but not paid for water service, shall receive a credit of \$412.00 against the charge levied in paragraph A hereof.

Section C: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

Section D: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect on $\frac{\sqrt{2}}{\sqrt{2}}$, 1993.
