A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BIRCH BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY

WHEREAS, pursuant to WAC 236.48.190, the Board of Commissioners ("Board") may transfer property belonging to the Birch Bay Water & Sewer District ("District") if the Board determines that the property is not and will not be needed for district purposes;

WHEREAS, the District Board has determined that the property listed on Exhibit A attached hereto is no longer needed for district purposes; and

WHEREAS, the District Board has determined that the aggregate value of the property listed on Exhibit A is Zero Dollars (\$0.00); and

WHEREAS, the District Board wishes to transfer said property to the Washington State Department of Ecology (DOE) for distribution to other public agencies in need of the equipment;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Birch Bay Water and Sewer District, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The property listed on Exhibit A is hereby declared surplus and is determined to have Zero value (\$0.00).

Section 2: The District Manager is hereby authorized to transfer the property listed on Exhibit A to the DOE.

Section 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid, or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution shall be in full force and effect.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
